### A simple and supportive way to enhance AEGC

The AEGC 250 Club was set up in order to provide 'wish list' items for the Club as well as rewarding those who make monthly contributions. Half the money collected is put into a pot for distributing equally to 4 lucky winners each draw and the other half set aside for the Club's 'wish list'.

In recent years, the money has been put towards the Club's new patio furniture, a defibrillator and contributed towards the cost of course machinery. We have also been able to give money to the Gardening Club to enhance the look of the course, particularly behind the 4<sup>th</sup> Green.

Ordinarily, the draws are held at AEGC social events:

- Captain's Drive – January
- Opening Sides – March
- Captain's weekend- June/July
- Closing Sides – October

Members of the AEGC 250 Club buy 'shares' by setting up a monthly direct debit, costing £5 a month. The member will then be given a number which will be entered into each quarterly draw. Members can buy as many numbers as they like!

To join the 250 Club, please complete this form, and hand it in to the Office. You also need to contact your bank to arrange a monthly £5 direct debit payment or monthly standing order payment. You will then be given a number which will be entered in to each draw.

## **AEGC 250 Club Constitution**

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1. The name of the prize draw is the AEGC 250 Club.
2. The purpose of the draw is to raise funds for the sole benefit of Alderley Edge Golf Club.
3. The draw will be administered by up to four Trustees, appointed by the Chairman of the Club and ratified by the AGM of the Club. At least one of the Trustees must be a Vice President.
4. The level of the prizes will be determined by the Trustees.
5. The draw will be open to anybody aged 16 or over. A purchaser of a share becomes a participant in the draw. Participants are entitled to hold any number of shares.
6. The number of shares in the draw shall be unlimited and each share shall be allocated a unique number. Participants may confirm the number of their allocated share (s) by contacting the Trustees.
7. The subscription for each share is £5 per month payable monthly in advance by direct debit or standing order. To be eligible for a quarterly draw, a completed direct debit or standing order must be received **BEFORE** the first day of the month of the draw period eg to be received by 31<sup>st</sup> March for the April to June draw.
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter - 1<sup>st</sup> April to 30<sup>th</sup> June
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter - 1<sup>st</sup> July to 30<sup>th</sup> September
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter - 1<sup>st</sup> October to 31<sup>st</sup> December
  - 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter - 1<sup>st</sup> January to 31<sup>st</sup> March
8. There shall be a draw made in each quarter using an automatic random number generator or other such means as the Trustees deem appropriate. All participants are entitled to attend the draws, which must be held in the presence of at least one Director of the Club, on such occasions and times as the Trustees shall deem appropriate.
9. Winners will be paid by electronic bank transfer or by cheque, which will be sent to the last known address held by the promoter. It is the responsibility of the participant to advise the Trustees of any change of address. Any prize cheque not cashed within 6 months will be deemed a donation to AEGC. A list of prize winning numbers will be published on the Club website.
10. The Trustees will not pay a prize to any participant other than the purchaser of the winning share.
11. No participant will be included in the draw if the subscription has not been received. It is the responsibility of each participant to make sure they have paid their subscription. The Trustees reserve the right to reallocate any number where payment has not been received.
12. Participants can cancel their entry in the Lottery at any time by giving one month's written notice to the Trustees via the Club Office. Any decision by the Club to end the draw will also be by one month's notice to all participants. By entering the draw Participants agree to be bound by the constitution of the AEGC 250 Club.
13. Under no circumstances can subscriptions be refunded.
14. The Trustees will determine any dispute. An appeal may be made to the Club Chairman whose decision shall be final.
15. The draw is intended to be a 'Small Society Lottery' under the provisions of the Gambling Act 2005, Section 19.
16. The Directors of Alderley Edge Golf Club may amend or vary the rules of the draw at any time. The rules of the draw will be available via the Club website. Changes will be notified to Participants via the Club website.
