FLEXI MEMBERSHIP – TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The Flexi membership fee entitles member to 100 points over a 12 month period
- 2. Points are used according to the Points Chart published on the Club website. Points used vary based on day of the week, and time of day. AEGC reserves the right to update this matrix periodically.
- 3. If 100 points have been fully used, an additional full flexi fee is due (for 100 points more). The 12 month membership period restarts from this date
- 4. If any points have not been used in the 12 month period from last membership renewal, a new full fee is payable but unused points can be transferred into the next membership year.
- 5. If member is about to use over 200 points in one calendar year (from initial renewal), an additional renewal will not be allowed. At this point the only option is full membership
- 6. From April 2024, flexi membership allows entry into a subset of the competitions managed by the club (subject to normal handicap rules). The list of these is at the discretion of the Council and the appropriate Golf Committees. Eligibility will be shown on the relevant BRS competition summary.

Indicatively, flexi membership allows entry into all comps (including senior comps, winter league etc.) apart from

- a. Majors (as defined by the appropriate golf committees)
- b. Singles and doubles knockouts
- c. Monthly stableford (first Saturday of each month in the summer season)
- d. Club Championships
- 7. Flexi members entering club managed competitions (including seniors, representative golf, home and away matches) will use the same number of points for the 18 holes competitions. Winter league (9 holes) will be as published matrix.
- 8. All members must book in on line or through the Pro-shop. Members cannot book unless they have sufficient credits available to use.

 Members turning up without a reservation must report to the Pro-shop before playing or at the bar should the Pro-shop be closed for any reason
- 9. Additional membership benefits (e.g. reduced bar prices, reduced fees for visitors playing with member etc) are also available to flexi members, but at the discretion of Council. Any changes will be notified as part of the annual membership fee review. The list of available benefits should be discussed with the club professional
- 10. Upgrade to full membership is available at any time. Any unused points at this time can be used to discount the first year's full membership fee (prorated in line with the flexi fee when the points were purchased)
